Ullman Design wins international gold award for superior craftsmanship

Ullman Design is pleased to announce that the studio has been awarded a Gold Award for superior craftsmanship of the invitation materials for Hanover College's inauguration of Dr. Sue DeWine by the International Association of Printing House Craftsmen (IAPHC). The award is in conjunction with Hopkins Printing of Columbus, Ohio, who printed the package.

The entry, designed by Christina Ullman, creative director, and Alix Northrup, associate creative director of Ullman Design, included a golden pearlized enclosure that contained invitation announcements, VIP parking tag, RSVP cards, and matching envelopes. The entry also included a matching commemorative program for the event.

This year's competition included thousands of entries from around the world, and was evaluated by more than three dozen international jurors in Minneapolis, Minn., in October 2008.

The awards competition is produced annually by the IAPHC, The Graphic Professionals Resource Network in support of the IAPHC's guiding purpose to Educate, Promote, Inform, and Connect (EPIC) its thousands of individual members and the global graphic community.

The International Gallery has solidified its premier position as a world-renowned graphic arts event. In 2008, entries originating in Britain, Australia, China, Italy, Russia, South Africa and many others joined hundreds of other entrants from around North America.

The honor qualifies the entry for consideration in the organization's Best of the Best awards, which will be awarded in spring 2009.
